Some organiser and press balloons may fly during the competition, however, their pilots will be briefed to maintain safe distance from competition balloons and the targets. They must not interfere with the competition.

## 6. Gas Refuelling

From 21<sup>st</sup> September 2020 flight to 25th September 2020, the Organizer will cover the refuelling. For all other flights the competitor will have to cover the cost after each refuelling, possible pay only with credit card. Fiesta has their own cost-system.

All cylinders must be removed from basked and must have the official stickers on them to be refuelled. The stickers will be distributed at pilot check-in.

- Balloon Annual / 100 Hour Inspection, if applicable
- Certificate of Airworthiness
- Certificate of Registration
- Certificate of Insurance
- Passport or Identity Document

But, please, make sure that you bring the **original documents** with you at check-in, even when you have submitted the copies online via the registration process.

#### 11. ID Cards

ID Cards will be issued for pilots, crew chiefs and crews at the check-in. You will be required to wear these ID Cards to enter the Common Launch area, Briefing area and Refuelling area during the event. Additional crew can also get ID Cards.















## 12. National Team Manager

National Team manager can also register. A place at the briefings will be arranged and competition documents handed out. To register, please fill out the form available from the official document page. The form must be signed by all competitors associated with the manager. He will then be considered a crew member of each team associated. Please hand in the form at check In.

# 13. Anti-doping and alcohol policy

WADA rules concerning anti-doping, including alcohol abuse, will be applied.

Intoxicated crew, including pilots, should be ordered to stop whatever ballooning activity they are currently participating in. The Safety Officer can take whatever action he feels appropriate and should immediately inform the Event Director.

If there is need for independent documentation, medical treatment or if otherwise deemed necessary, police or emergency services will be asked for assistance.

If you are using a drug that is on the WADA list of Prohibited Substances and Methods but is prescribed by a medical doctor, you must have a document from your national sport authority showing that you have an official exemption. In such a case, please report this to the Event Director.

Note: The legal limit for ordinary drivers is Slovenia is 50 mg of alcohol per 100 ml of blood or 0.24 milligrams of alcohol per litre of exhaled air.

The legal blood alcohol limit for flying in Slovenia is 0 mg/ml.

## 15. Practice Flights

For all practice flights please be aware of the following:

Responsibility: You will operate your equipment under your own responsibility at any time.

Schedule: see under 1-Schedule

Briefing: TBD

Flying Area: Practice flights are only permitted in Slovenian airspace and outside all PZ. Slovenian

air-law applies at all times and to all aerial activities.

The maximum flying altitude is 7500ft MSL.

Target display: A target will be displayed at the CLA.

PZs: All PZ, as defined in the rules, are also in force during all practice flights.

IMPORTANT: Each infringement of a PZ, altitude or boundary, may jeopardize the good conduct of the competition afterwards! Please be very careful!

Refuelling cost: For all practice flights propane will be available at own cost from the event organisers.

Each refuelling will be pay immediately, accept only credit card!

Price for gas: 1.39€/Kg

Landowner: Please respect the landowners land and cattle and take special care to consider them

as our hosts who are due our best consideration. Any complaint from a land-owner

should be directed immediately to the event organisers or the event officials.

## 16. General Briefing

Attending the General briefing is compulsory for pilots and officials. Each pilot can attend with their crew chief.















## 17. Task Briefing

Only pilots and crew chiefs are allowed to enter the briefings. Each pilot can attend with their crew chief.

## 18. Breakfast

#### 19. Recall Procedure

Recall will primarily be done by WhatsApp. It is therefore recommended for the pilot AND the crew chief to be equipped with working SIM cards and phones with installed application. Please make sure to note both phone numbers (if already known) in the registration form or at check-in.

## 20. Extra Mobile Phone and SIM cards

National SIM cards and mobile phones will be possibility to buy in the city.

#### 21. Airspace

Airspace limitations are defined in the event rules. Special, updated or additional limitations will be announced latest at the General briefing.

Drone flying is heavily restricted in Slovenia. Even if permission is obtained by the Slovenian civil aviation authorities, it is not allowed to fly drones in or near MMAs and CLAs unless explicit permission has been obtained by the organiser and event director.















#### 22. Air band radio

As of January 1st, 2018, a new European regulation makes the use of VHF 8.33kHz voice channel spacing in European airspace mandatory. Please be aware that during the event checks may be made by the regulation authorities.

Furthermore, a take-off without permission may be made from minor roads or tracks, if the balloon envelope can be laid out in the adjacent field provided, it is freshly harvested and/or not cultivated, and no damage is done. The road traffic may not be blocked.
