Section II

II.1 Contest Area (7.1)

The competition map will consist of one sheet specially printed for the Event, each for Leszno and Dolsk.

The maps have the map datum WGS84 and map grid UTM/UPS.

The contest area in Leszno limited by coordinates: 8613/6009, 6317/6258, 3362/2721, 8807/2472.

The contest area in Dolsk described as circle with radius 17km and center point on coordinates 3621/6335.

Magnetic declination for both areas: 4°58"

II. 2 OUT OF BOUNDS (7.2)

All PZs as described in II.3 are considered as Out of Bounds areas unless otherwise stated in the task data.

For the flight in Dolsk, the area outside of the Dolsk contest area which is described in II.1 is Out Of Bounds. The regular Visual Flight Rules (VFR) will apply in this area.

II.12 - GOALS SELECTED BY A COMPETITOR

Competitors will not be required to declare goals by reference to map features (junctions, houses, etc).

When declaring a goal, competitors will be scored to the declared coordinates and altitude. If the declared altitude is below the ground or no altitude is declared, they will be scored to the 2D/3D separation altitude. In such case, any distance infringements will be applied to the goal as if it was declared at the separation altitude (see Rule 13.3.6).

- Launch masters will not be used.
